

ABOUT THE PROGRAM



In July 2023, the U.S. Department of Labor (DOL) approved the National Guidelines for Apprenticeship Standards for the NECA/ELECTRI Project Management Apprenticeship.



The program is intended to introduce apprentices to the entry-level aspects of Project Management. By the end of the program, the apprentice will:

- Complete 2,000 on-the-job training hours with the hosting contractor company
- Earn a Certificate in Construction Project
 Management through the related instruction requirement

Provide policy and guidance to employers, employer associations and their local affiliates in developing Standards of Apprenticeship for local approval and registration



Certified by the Office of Apprenticeship (OA) Training, Employer and Labor Services, U. S. Department of Labor



State Apprenticeship Agency (SAA)/Councils recognized by the Bureau of Apprenticeship and Training to register local programs, and/or local laws and regulations, may impose additional requirements that must be addressed in the local apprenticeship standards
