The National Electrical Code





KEY ELEMENTS OF NEW 110.17

Who and How:

- Qualified Persons trained in Service and Maintenance
- In accordance with OEM:
 - Instructions and information
 - Product listing information
 - Applicable industry Standards (NFPA 70B)
 - As approved by the AHJ

Replacement Parts:

- Must use identified replacement parts verified under applicable product standards.
- Replacement parts must comply with one of these:
 - Provided by OEM
 - Designed by an experienced engineer.
 - Approved by AHJ (See 110.3)








NFPA 70B, Standards for Electrical Equipment Maintenance





How has NFPA 70B evolved?

- NFPA 70B was escalated to a Standard in 2023.
 - Same development process as all NFPA documents
 - Technical Committee with balanced Membership Classifications
- Provisions written in mandatory text
 - SHALL instead of SHOULD.
- Industry Interest was high!
 - 707 Public Comments for 2023; <10 PCs for 2019 Edition








The Focus of NFPA 70B


Primary Focal Points:

 - Condition of Maintenance is part of 70E Electrical Safety Program


